CSU Search Committee Continues to Review Chancellor Applications

The Colorado State University System chancellor search committee met today to begin deliberations on more than a dozen applicants who have met the minimum qualifications. The committee chairs have asked that applications be shared with the 15-member committee in advance to allow members adequate time to carefully review them.

The committee will meet again on Thursday, April 16 to continue to review applications and deliberate. The search committee will accept applications until the position is filled.

The Colorado State University System Board of Governors voting members are appointed by the Governor, and confirmed by the State Senate, to serve up to two consecutive four-year terms. The board consists of nine voting members representing diverse backgrounds reflective of Colorado.
