The Colorado State University System today announced CSU's Commitment to Colorado, a new financial aid program to assist lower and middle-income students with tuition and fees. With this commitment, CSU is making it clear to parents and families that a university education is an option for all our children.

Commitment to Colorado Programs

The programs will be effective fall 2011. Students must be a Colorado resident, undergraduate, pursuing their first Bachelor's degree.

CSU's Commitment to Colorado is a pledge to provide Colorado students who have a family Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of \$57,000 or less (and who meet other eligibility requirements) with grant funds from state and university sources to cover at least one-half the cost of tuition. In addition, those students who are eligible for a federal Pell Grant will receive grant funds from federal, state and university sources to cover 100% of tuition and standard fees.

CSU-Pueblo's Commitment to Colorado program is a guarantee to admitted full-time resident undergraduates with a family adjusted gross income of \$50,000 or less who receive a Pell grant that they will not have to pay tuition or mandatory student fees.
